October Meeting...

Officer Involved Shootings Part 2—This month's meeting our guest speaker will be Sgt McNamara. He will be discussing the other side of officer involved shootings and what is done when this happens.

September Meeting Recap...

Part 1—Officer Involved Shootings...Our Guest Speaker was Officer Woolsey. Ofc. Woolsey took us through the details of an officer involved shooting which he was involved on October 4, 2016 at 8:00 p.m.

Ofc. Woolsey explained the moments that lead up to the event and the results. He then took us through the process he had to endure after the shooting, including himself being treated as evidence which involved being isolated from everyone, his pistol and magazines removed from his possession.

When there is an officer involved shooting it is mandatory that State Police are called in immediately to open an investigation. In addition, the Union Lawyer is immediately called. Officer involved shootings must be investigated by outside departments and they cannot be investigated by internal departments.

Ofc. Woolsey further stated that it is very beneficial for the Officer involved to have the support of family and co-workers while going through the aftermath of a OIS. Physically, your body goes through an extreme adrenaline dump which becomes physically exhausting, having the family and coworker support to get through those times is invaluable.
