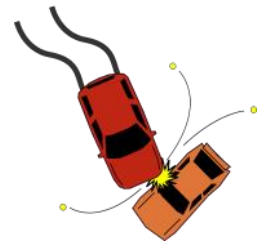

This month our guest speaker will be discussing what is done for accident reconstruction. Do don't miss this great opportunity

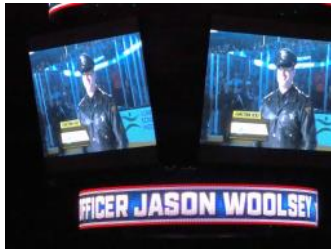


January Meeting Recap..

Our January Meeting entailed splitting up into two groups and as one group went to the range while the other stayed back for a brief business meeting.



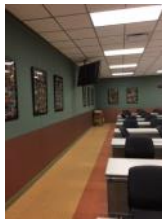
Chicago Wolves Hometown Hero...

 ..Well done and keep up the good work!

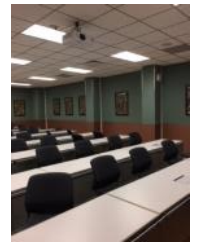
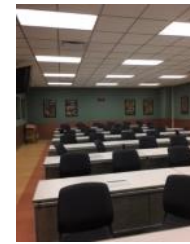


Framed Police Patch Project...
