Our guest speaker for February was Kevin Vosburgh, who is a consultant for a forensic engineering firm. His firm is hired, often by court order, when an investigation is underway which involves an automobile or industrial accident, and the loss of life or extreme injury has occurred. His firm analyzes the data from the vehicles black box, airbag control modules which are located throughout the car and main data points. All of these devices draw a picture of moments before the accident occurred and can include speed, when an airbag deployed and GPS locations to name a few. All data is compiled and analyzed and a report is then written which states the facts of the accident.
