August Meeting Recap...

Sgt. Spayth of the ATF, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives presented a history of the ATF and the connection to Aurora. ATF is now part of the Justice Dept with two branches – Regulatory and Criminal Enforcement. During the early 2000s, an undercover informant was used and 16 gang members were charged federally which led to a reduction in crime. From that the ATF task force was formed in 2005. NIBIN – National Integrated Ballistic Information Network – is now used to get faster results, narrow down current activity and put the puzzle pieces together.

ATF Intel Analysts and Evidence Techs are on site. ATF has task force offices in Chicago, Rockford and Aurora – fully funded by the ATF. The ATF is a highly specialized organization dedicated to investigating violent criminals and helping keep America's communities safe.

Kane County Jail Tours...

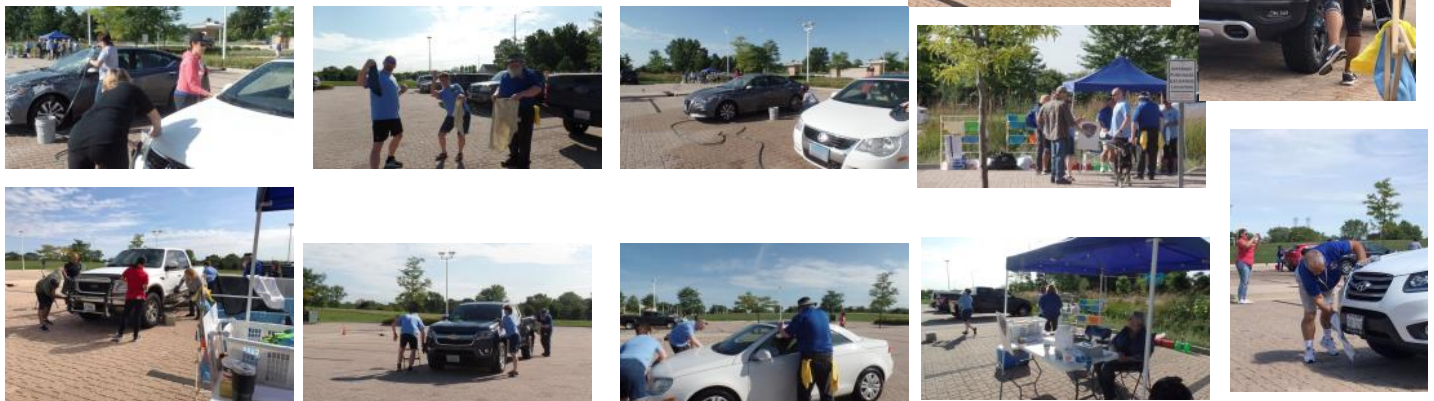
