## PHOTO OF VEHICLE WANTED FOR QUESTIONING RELEASED IN UNSOLVED 2018 FATAL HIT AND RUN CRASH

[AURORA, Ill. – February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020]: The Aurora Police Department is releasing a picture of a vehicle wanted for questioning in an unsolved 2018 fatal hit and run crash that killed 46-year-old Daniel Anderson in Aurora.

The crash happened at 6:40 p.m. on January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2018 on the Near East Side at Broadway Avenue (Rt. 25) at Hazel Avenue.

The suspect vehicle is believed to be a light-colored van. The picture is from a nearby security video camera that captured the van driving away from the scene.

## HIT AND RUN CRASH

[AURORA, Ill. – January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020]: We're looking for witnesses and information on a fatal hit and run crash that occurred around 6:40 p.m. Jan. 24 on the Near East Side.

The victim, a 46 year old homeless Aurora man, was crossing Broadway Ave. (Rt. 25) in the crosswalk at Hazel Ave. with another 32 year old Aurora man. As they started crossing westbound, the 32 year old saw an older gray minivan traveling southbound on Broadway. The 32 year old man stopped in the middle of the crosswalk and hollered to the 46 year old man to stop, but the victim ran westbound in front of the minivan and was struck. The driver of the minivan stopped for a few seconds but then fled southbound.

The victim, whose name is being withheld until his family can be notified, was taken by Aurora Fire Department Paramedics to an Aurora hospital. He was then airlifted to a suburban hospital and was pronounced dead at 1:50 a.m. today, Jan. 25.

There is no further description of the minivan nor its occupants. The only photos of the vehicle we have so far are of poor quality and were taken from an area surveillance camera.

Volunteers from Aurora's Emergency Management Agency assisted at the crash scene. The stretch of Broadway where the crash occurred was blocked off until about 10:30 a.m. for APD Traffic and General Assignment Investigators and Evidence Technicians.
