## AURORA POLICE INVESTIGATING MAN SHOT ON CITY'S WEST SIDE

The Aurora Police Department is investigating a shooting that sent one man to the hospital on the city's west side late Wednesday afternoon.

At 5:15 p.m., officers were dispatched to reports of a person shot in the 800 block of Oliver Avenue. When officers arrived, they found a 20-year-old man suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. Aurora Fire Department paramedics transported the man to an area hospital, where he was listed in serious but stable condition.

Detectives from the Aurora Police Department's Bureau of Investigations responded to the scene and began investigating the specific circumstances of the incident. Evidence Technicians also responded to the scene to identify and collect forensic evidence from the shooting.

Detectives are still investigating the circumstances of the shooting, but preliminary information shows that the shooting appears to be gang-related.
