Battery Incidents

About the crime:

The Aurora Police Department is alerting the community about two recent battery incidents in the area of Phillips Park in Aurora. In both incidents, the male offender was riding a bicycle when he approached a female jogger and slapped them on their buttocks as they were running. The offender then fled the area on his bicycle.

Times and locations of the incidents:

- 1000 blk Pleasant Pl. (Phillips Dog Park) June 16, 2020 at 9:40 a.m.
- Morningside Av/Smith Bl. (Phillips Park Path) June 20, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.

Offender information:

- Black male, 20-30 years old, 5'11", 150 lbs, wearing black pants, navy blue t-shirt with a durag on his head, riding a blue/gray ten speed style bicycle

What you can do:

- Dial 911 immediately and remain on scene when safe to do so.
- Always be aware of your surroundings and be cautious of contact with unknown persons
- Remember any unique physical characteristics of the offender (i.e., scars, tattoos, acne).
- Never pursue a fleeing offender, provide as much information to the police
