AURORA POLICE INVESTIGATING THREE PEOPLE SHOT ON CITY'S EAST SIDE

The Aurora Police Department is investigating a shooting on the city's east side that sent three people to the hospital early Sunday morning.

Just after 4:00 a.m., Aurora's 911 Center received a call of a person shot in the 100 block of Trask Street. When officers arrived on the scene, they found a 26-year-old suffering from gunshot wounds. Aurora Fire Department paramedics transported the man to an area hospital, where he is listed in critical condition.

A short time later, a 28-year-old man and an 18-year-old woman arrived at an Aurora hospital also suffering from gunshots wounds. The 28-year-old man was treated and released from the hospital. The 18-year-old female remains hospitalized and is currently listed in serious, but stable condition.

Detectives from the Aurora Police Department's Bureau of Investigations responded to the scene and began investigating the circumstances of the shooting. Evidence Technicians also responded to the scene to identify and collect forensic evidence from the shooting.
