UPDATE: MAN KILLED AFTER BEING STRUCK BY TWO VEHICLES IN HIT AND RUN CRASH ON CITY'S EAST SIDE

UPDATE: The man has been identified as 55-year-old Tracy Holland of the 1000 block of Pheasant Run Lane.

The crash remains under investigation and traffic investigators are still searching for the second vehicle involved in the incident.

MAN KILLED AFTER BEING STRUCK BY TWO VEHICLES IN HIT AND RUN CRASH ON CITY'S EAST SIDE

The Aurora Police Department is investigating after a man was killed after being struck by two vehicles on the city's east side.

Just before 10:00 p.m., Aurora's 911 Center received reports of a person struck by a vehicle on Ogden Avenue just west of Long Grove Drive. Aurora Police officers and the Aurora Fire Department arrived on the scene and found a man lying in the roadway. Paramedics attempted to perform lifesaving measures, but unfortunately pronounced the man dead on the scene.

Responding officers immediately began gathering information and learned witnesses saw two vehicles strike the man. The first vehicle pulled off into a nearby parking lot and waited to speak to officers, but the other vehicle fled the scene. Officers are currently following up on leads to locate the second vehicle.

Aurora Police's Traffic Division responded to the scene to begin conducting an investigation into the crash. Traffic investigators used state-of-the-art drone technology to create a 3D digital map of the scene that allows investigators to see specific details and measurements of the scene.

Ogden Avenue remained closed between South Frontenac Street and Village Green Drive while traffic investigators reconstructed the accident. Emergency Volunteer Service members from Aurora's Emergency Management Agency provided light trucks and street blockades to assist with road closures and scene lighting.

The investigation into the circumstances of the crash is on-going. Anyone with information about the accident is asked to call the Aurora Police Department's Traffic Division at 630-256-5330 or call Crime Stoppers at 630-892-1000 to report information anonymously.
