Officers immediately responded to the bank and searched the area, but were unable to locate the person or persons involved in the incident.

The FBI has been requested to the scene. Because bank robberies are a federal crime, the FBI is the primary agency charged with investigating them. APD will assist our federal law enforcement partners with their investigation.
