Updated Temporary Rules for Permitted Peddlers/Solicitors and Participants in Charitable Solicitations Campaigns (as of March 11, 2022)

The novel Corona Virus or COVID-19 has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, Federal and State governments recommend physical and social distancing.

Pursuant to the authority conferred upon the City Clerk by Chapter 32, Sec. 32-7 of the City of Aurora Code of Ordinances, the City Clerk hereby adopts the following temporary regulations regarding all permitted peddlers/solicitors and all participants in permitted charitable solicitations campaigns in the City of Aurora. Until further notice, while participating in peddling/soliciting and/or charitable solicitations campaigns in the City of Aurora, all individuals must adhere to the following requirements:

- **While on private property, a Peddler/Solicitor shall promptly comply with a request from a resident of said property to wear a mask covering their mouth and nose. The Peddler/Solicitor shall regard compliance with such a request as a condition of remaining on the resident's property.**
- **Strict adherence to "NO SOLICITORS" signs. Do not approach or leave flyers or business materials at a home that has posted a "NO SOLICITORS" sign.**
- **Peddlers/Solicitors shall wear and display their City-issued badge at all times.**
- **Participants in a charitable solicitations campaign shall carry a copy of the permit issued to the charitable organization with them at all times while soliciting and shall allow any resident to view their permit upon request.**

Please review Chapter 32 of the City of Aurora Code of Ordinances prior to peddling/soliciting or participating in a charitable solicitations campaign in the City of Aurora. Failure to strictly follow these Temporary Rules, as well as the rules contained in Chapter 32 of the City of Aurora Code of Ordinances, will subject the individual peddler/solicitor as well as his/her parent company to penalties as identified in Sec 32-51 of the Code of Ordinances.
