



IRRIGATION SYSTEMS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

Lawn sprinkler / irrigation systems within the public right-of-way must be approved and permitted by the City of Aurora before being installed. This permit process is not intended to in any way approve or warrant the irrigation system installed. The following conditions are required for approval:

1. All contractors (including homeowners) working in the public right-of-way shall possess a valid Public Works-General license in addition to any applicable plumbing license. Public Works licensure is made through the Engineering Division located on the 4th floor of City Hall (630) 256-3200.
2. In accordance with Section 48-31 of the Municipal Code, all properties with permanently installed, automatically controlled irrigation systems may operate those systems daily between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. prevailing time, no evening watering allowed. At no time can the water from such system be sprayed onto the street. Between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 9:00 A.M., the water from such system cannot be sprayed onto the public sidewalk. Failure to conform to this requirement after two written notices may result in a requirement to remove the system at the owner's expense.
3. It is understood that the public right-of-way is reserved for the placement of utilities as well as public movement. If, during the installation or repair of any utility, sidewalk or other public improvement results in damage to an irrigation system located in the public right-of-way, the owner of said system shall bear all responsibility and costs associated with its repair.
4. Should a private irrigation system become obsolete, nonfunctional, poorly maintained, protruding from grade, in violation of this policy or some other such problem cited by the City, then in that event, the City may require repair or removal of all or a portion of such system within 30 days of written notice from the City to do so. If the owner fails to so repair or remove, then after two such written notices to the owner, the City may cause removal of the system at the owner's expense, and may file a lien against the property for all costs involved.

By signing this document, the Property Owner, or its Legal Representative, hereby acknowledges that the City of Aurora shall have no responsibility and is hereby held harmless from any liability for damage which may occur to an irrigation system which is placed in whole or in part within the public right-of-way.
