

VICTIM/COMPLAINT INFORMATION GUIDE

The following information has been prepared by the Aurora Police Department and the Kane, DuPage, Kendall and Will County State's Attorney's Offices as an informative guide to those who are unfamiliar with the process involved in signing a criminal complaint to have someone arrested.

Kane County Misdemeanor/Felony

Your case will be assigned to an Aurora Police Department Investigator for further investigation. If you want to pursue a criminal complaint and the case involves a family or household member, contact the Domestic Violence Reduction Unit (630) 256-5530. If the case does not involve a family or household member, please contact the Investigations Division (630) 256-5500. If the defendant in your complaint is under eighteen (18) years of age, contact the Juvenile Division at (630) 256-5500. Also, please refer to the report number on the courtesy card given to you by the reporting officer, or the number listed at the bottom of this page.

DuPage County Misdemeanor/Felony

Your case will be assigned to an Aurora Police Department Investigator for further investigation.
