ORDINANCE NO. 019-066
DATE OF PASSAGE October 8, 2019

An Ordinance Amending Chapter 6 of the City of Aurora Code of Ordinances Entitled "Alcoholic Liquor".

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of its home rule powers, it is necessary and desirable for the City of Aurora to amend its ordinances regarding Alcoholic Liquor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Aurora, Illinois, as follows:

Section One: That Chapter 6 of the City of Aurora Code of Ordinances shall be and hereby is amended as set forth in Exhibit A:

Section Two: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect, and shall be controlling, upon its passage and approval.

Section Three: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

Section Four: That any section or provision of this ordinance that is construed to be invalid or void shall not affect the remaining sections or provisions which shall remain in full force and effect thereafter.

20. Class T-Full Service Salon and Spa.

a. Authorizes the licensee to provide beer and wine only, either complementary or for retail sale (all applicable sales tax apply with retail sale of alcohol), for consumption on the specified premises, as an adjunct to a principal full service personal care services establishment such as a hair salon, barbershop, day spa, or nail salon. The issuance of a Class T license shall be expressly subject to the following conditions:

1. The licensee may provide patrons of the business with individual servings of wine or beer in glasses ~~at no charge~~ complimentary or for retail sale.
2. No wine or beer may be served to persons on the business premises except as a complement to the patron's purchase or consumption of goods and services made available to the public by the licensee.
3. The complimentary service, retail sale or consumption of beer or wine at the licensed premises is limited to not more than three alcoholic beverages by a patron during any single calendar day.
4. It shall be unlawful for the licensee, its agents, and employees to permit any patron to leave the licensed premises with an open container of wine or beer.
5. The licensee must maintain general liability insurance coverage in such minimum amounts as the Liquor Commissioner may deem necessary from time to time, and shall present the Liquor Commissioner with a certificate of insurance reflecting such insurance coverage prior to the issuance of a Class T license.
6. All employees who perform corkage/serving duties shall have successfully completed a certified BASSET training program and shall serve the wine and beer as if it was purchased in the establishment, complying with all State and local laws. Such employees must be at least twenty-one years (21) of age or older.
6. No bar or lounge as defined in this Chapter shall be available for customer use on the premises.
7. Video gaming on the premises is prohibited.




