Veterans Assistance Criteria

Aurora Veterans Advisory Council

Our program provides qualified veterans with one-time assistance to meet basic needs as determined by their county Veterans Assistance Commission. Completing the county Application for Veterans Assistance is the first step in receiving financial aid from AVAC. Residence in Aurora, Illinois is required. Only veterans with an Honorable Discharge or General Discharge Under Honorable Conditions are eligible.

Payments will be paid directly to the creditor/vendor by AVAC. The check will never be made to the veteran.
