Instructions

- 1** If permit is for a multi-family structure, please complete the form by documenting the number of bedrooms per multi-family residential unit being removed and added in the structure. For non-residential structures, please document the individual types plumbing outlets being removed and added in the structure. If building is a combination Residential/Non-Residential, please complete form as indicated above for each use. If more than one structure on a parcel where proposed changes to plumbing is occurring, please combine on sheet all work in all buildings.
- 2** If plumbing changes are occurring on multiple structures which are on multiple parcels of land, please complete separate sheets for each parcel.
- 3** Form must be signed & sealed by an Illinois Registered Professional Engineer or Illinois Licensed Architect certifying that the residential unit - fixture count is correct and accurate.
- 4** The form is to be submitted to the City of Aurora Engineering Division for review and fee determination. Please be sure to attach the "Project Information Sheet" with your submittal. The "Project Information Sheet" can be found on the Engineering Division website, www.aurora-il.org/development_services/publicworks/engineering. When the fee is determined, it will be applied to the building permit fees.
- 5** If there is a specific special fixture, outlet or piece of equipment that does not fall into one of the types shown, please either add a line to the form or attach a sheet identifying the special item, how many of that item and what building/parcel it belongs to.
