RULES GOVERNING THE ISSUANCE AND USE OF RESIDENT/SCHOOL PARKING PERMITS:

- The Resident/School Parking Permit allows you to park on streets where parking is prohibited during the school session or in an Area of Concern. This permit does not allow you to park in violation of other parking restrictions.
- In order to secure a permit, the resident must present two forms of identification (including current registration for the permitted vehicle) indicating that they reside at the address for which the permit is being issued.
- Vehicle displaying permit must be registered to the owner at that address.
- The permit is only valid on the street in front of the residence indicated on the permit.
- A maximum of two permits per household may be issued. Multi-unit residences receive one permit per unit.
- There will be a \$15.00 fee for replacement of lost or stolen permits.
- Permits are valid for the current year only and must be renewed annually.
- Unauthorized use of permits will result in permanent revocation of permit privileges.
- Failure to properly display the permit may result in the vehicle being cited.
- Any outstanding balances with the city of Aurora must be brought current before permits will be issued.
